Harassment Policy

Harassment, including sexual harassment, is contrary to basic standards of conduct between individuals. Any BCEA member or volunteer who engages in any acts or behavior of harassment violates Barren County Economic Authority policy, and such misconduct will subject the participant to immediate removal from their volunteer responsibilities.

A staff member or volunteer who feels that he or she has been subjected to harassment should immediately report the matter to the Executive Director of the Barren County Economic Authority. If Executive Director is the source of the alleged harassment, the participant is to report the problem to the Chairman of the BCEA. Discretion and due diligence will be utilized in investigating and, where appropriate, remedying improper conduct. There will be no retaliation against the participant who, in good faith, seeks resolution under the policy.
